2021 Open Enrollment

We are in the final week of open enrollment for coverage beginning January 1, 2021. Open enrollment is a period of time when you can enroll for health insurance or change your plan. Open enrollment ends on December 15, 2020.

New Mexicans will have two new options for health insurance for 2021, Friday Health Plans and Western Sky Community Care (Ambetter/Centene). Additionally, Molina, Blue Cross Blue Shield of New Mexico, and True Health will be returning with plan offerings for 2021.

Centennial Care Year Round Enrollment

If your income is at or below 138% of the Federal Poverty Level (approximately \$17,236 for a single person household or \$35,535 for a family of four), you may be eligible. Visit www.yes.state.nm.us to apply.

Flu Awareness and Vaccine Clinics Near You

The CDC recommends a yearly flu vaccine as the most important step in protecting against the flu. People at high risk of flu complication include young children, pregnant women, people over the age of 65, and people with chronic conditions, such as asthma, diabetes, heart or lung disease. Anyone can get the flu and complications, such as pneumonia, can lead to hospitalization. Protect your family from getting the flu by getting vaccinated.
